

Snowsports Website COVID Procedures 2020-21 11-12-2020

All Snowsports Employees and Guests must wear a face covering when inside all lodges (lunch exception), at lineup areas, in registration lines, in lift lines and on lifts, and during a lesson when not actively skiing.

All guests taking lessons will be required to fill a **health screening questionnaire**. Day customers will complete one within Creekside Lodge registration desks and Night customers may complete one with an assigned instructor. Employees complete a daily health screening report. Parents of 3-5 year olds may accompany their kids in lessons due to high physical contact involved in teaching youth. If the student is unable to complete the lesson, parents may be called for pickup. **Kids lessons will be limited to max 6 students and adults max 10.**

Online registration is recommended for group lessons. There will be a separate line for preregistered guests and walk ups through the Creekside doors facing the Main Lodge. Creekside will be one way in and out and Adults and Children will register through the same line. Please follow distancing and face covering procedures while you are in line and inside the building. ***On peak holidays (Christmas week, MLK weekend and Presidents Week), Snowsports will only accept guests who have preregistered or booked a private reservation in advance. NO WALK UPS will be sold.***

Creekside lodge eating area is for students in lessons ONLY. No guests, parents, or family are allowed inside the eating area. It will be sanitized and waste disposed of between staggered lunches. Lunches will be staggered to allow for group distancing and cohorts. Students taking full day lessons must wear their masks anytime inside Creekside lodge with the exception of when sitting and eating.

Students in a lesson may ride a lift together, however if the guest prefers to ride alone that may be accommodated. Guests who prefer to be taught in a small group with their friends or family may purchase a private lesson. Private lessons may include up to four guests.

Seasonal Programs will be assigned to smaller cohorts within their groups. Cohorts will sit together in assigned seats for lunch and may remove face coverings only when seated for lunch. While inside, groups will be spaced 6 or more feet apart and will remain away from other groups while on snow. Students will not ride the lift with members of the public.

The Training Center is open for athletes only. Athletes may get ready inside with a mask on and leave their bags in an assigned area daily. No items may be kept at the Training Center overnight and no parents may enter the Training Center at any point throughout the day. **Snowsports Locker rooms are for employees only.** No guests or visitors are permitted in the Training Center this season.

Competitions hosted by the Training Center will follow the "Interim Guidance for Professional Sports Competitions with no fans during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency."

Lounsbury Adaptive lessons will run out of Creekside Lodge or the Adaptive building adjacent to Tannenbaum Lodge. Reservations are required for all lessons at laspski@hotmail.com and paperwork is required to be returned before the lesson date. Guests must wear masks at all times inside a building and when not actively sliding. Parents may be asked to assist guests based on needs of assistance. The Lounsbury Building and Creekside lodge do NOT have storage available for guests belongings. All personal items must be kept in your car.
